

**Community Grants Awarded
2012 – 2013**

The Community Grants program was established to support local non-profit organizations which do important work every day to address the educational, civic and cultural needs of Muhlenberg County. Of the approximately \$2.2 million in annual grants awarded by the Board of Directors, approximately \$200,000 is set aside annually for the Community Grants Program. Qualifying organizations are invited to submit an application and grants are awarded quarterly. Since the establishment of the Foundation in 2008, almost \$1.9 million in Community Grants has been awarded in addition to the \$9 million in grants initiated by the Board of Directors and Task Force.
