

**Community Grants Awarded
2014-2015**

The Community Grants program was established to support local non-profit organizations which do important work every day to address the educational, civic and cultural needs of Muhlenberg County. Of the approximately \$2.2 million in annual grants awarded by the Board of Directors, approximately \$200,000 is set aside annually for the Community Grants Program. Qualifying organizations are invited to submit an application and grants are awarded quarterly. In addition to the \$18.7 million in grants initiated by the Board of Directors and Task Force, the Foundation has awarded almost Community Grants totaling over \$2.3 million to over 60 organizations serving Muhlenberg County.
